Aw the Gether

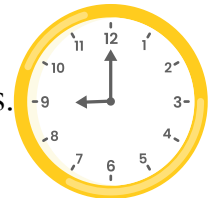
In Personal Support



Pupils should attend their Personal Support class at 8.45am.

In Personal Support, pupils should expect to:

- be greeted by their Personal Support Teacher on arrival
- be settled quickly in designated seats
- be reminded that jackets should be removed and phones should be out of sight
- have someone check if they are in uniform
- be registered and receive any handouts/ letters/ reports.
- hear the daily bulletin
- see the Aw the Gether Wellbeing input on the screen
- See their YHs and Pastoral Support Teacher most mornings.
- be dismissed at 8:55 to attend their period 1 class ready for learning.



Aw the Gether weekly input:

Merit Monday - pupils will be recognised for weekly merits and House point updates

Take Notice Tuesday - pupils will have short input on a topic which raises awareness of local, national and global issues

We Say Wednesday - pupils get a chance to feedback their views and receive updates from Pupil Parliament

Thoughtful Thursday - pupils consider reflective question. This is usually based on relevant issues around wellbeing and learning.

Feel Good Friday - the class vote on a song which is played on the screen.

The purpose of Personal Support:

- allows pupils to see one key member of staff each morning
- sets a positive tone for the day, to ensure pupils are ready for learning
- builds a sense of belonging to class, House, Year and wider school
- Keeps pupils up to date with what is happening within school and recognise success
- Allows pupils to share their views and gain a sense of involvement in the wider school
- establishes good routines and timekeeping for learning, life and work.
